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FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: City of Umatilla Announces Vacancy for City Council Seat 4

Umatilla, OR- MAY 22, 2025— The City of Umatilla is officially announcing a vacancy for City Council Seat 4 following the resignation of Councilor Ashley Wheeler as she moved to Idaho to support her family. The City Council is now accepting applications from interested individuals who meet the eligibility requirements:

- 1) be registered to vote,
- 2) have resided in the city limits of Umatilla for a least one year immediately before appointment (no later than 7/1/2024), and
- 3) must not be employed by the City of Umatilla.

<u>Application Process:</u>

Interested candidates can submit their applications online through the City's official website. The <u>application form</u> is the same as for other committee vacancies, simply check the "City Council" box on the form. All applications must be submitted **no later than 1:00 pm on June 27, 2025.**

Interviews and Appointment:

All applicants will be interviewed during the City Council Meeting on July 1, 2025. The City Council will conduct formal interviews with each candidate, and the appointment to City Council Seat 4 will be made later that same evening.

Duration:

This will be considered an appointed term. The appointee will serve through the next General Election (11/4/2025). If the appointee is interested in serving beyond this date, they will need to file for the general election, at which time the voters will decide on who will serve the remainder of the term through December 2028.
